

District 6960 Supported International Global Grants 2018-2019

District Wide Priority Global Grant Projects:

- The District will select 3 priority projects to be offered for district wide participation. Information regarding these projects will be communicated after July 1, 2018.
- The clubs that participate in the priority projects will submit their club cash to The Rotary Foundation APF, rather than to the grant.
- The APF donation will be matched 2:1 with District Designated Funds, up to \$5,000 APF/ \$10,000 DDF per priority grant.

Individual Club Global Grants:

- Global Grants may be submitted anytime during the Rotary Year. There is no deadline for submission.

Clubs are required to email a PDF of the global grant to jfusco@bankunited.com for review prior to submitting the grant to TRF.

- Jeff Fusco will provide sign off on the grant application to DG Pete Doragh and District TRF Chair Steve Schlueter for their authorization of District Designated Funds.
- Once the grant is approved, clubs participating in the grant will submit the club cash to The Rotary Foundation APF.
- The APF donation will be matched 1:1 with District Designated Funds, up to \$15,000 maximum per grant/project.
- Clubs that participate beyond the maximum DDF match must submit club cash to the grant project rather than APF.
- Each club may lead no more than one Global Grant that includes matching DDF from 6960.

Minimum Criteria for Club Eligibility

- The Club must be certified for the 2018-19 year by at least one responsible member attending a District lead Grant Management seminar by April 5, 2018.
- The Club must give the District TRF Chair Steve Schlueter a TRF MOU and a District MOU for the 2018-19 year by May 15, 2018.
- Club dues to the District and Rotary International and Semi-Annual reports must have been filed by August 31, 2017 and February 28, 2018 respectively.
- No Global Grant or District Grant paperwork due from the Club shall be past its due date at the time a grant application is approved.
- Club President Elect (President 2018-19) attended PETS or a substitute Training approved by the District Governor.
